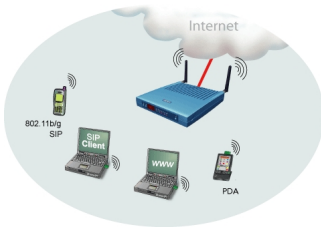


The Internet Gate as a Wireless Access Point

- A soft SIP client in your laptop and you can make and receive phone calls as soon as getting an Internet connection
- Full SIP functionality via wireless: Voice, video, presence, instant messaging and more.
- Your PDA with a SIP client becomes a SIP phone

What are the steps to get there?

1. Use a wireless 802.11b/g version of the Internet Gate
2. Just allow your PC, laptop or PDA to connect to the wireless network and you get full SIP connectivity

Note!

- Turn off any tricks in the clients that may try to open holes in NATs and firewalls, such as STUN and UPnP
